<u>Locaton / Unit Dsecription:</u>

Instructions: This log will be maintained for <u>each</u> refrigerator and freezer (both walk-in and reach-in units) in the facility. A designated person will record the time, temperature, and their initials. The LDA's Operational Manual requires it to be done once a day. The supervisor should verify monthly that temperatures have been taken and sign off at the end of each month. Please keep all logs for a minimum of 3 years. If corrective action is required on any day, circle the date in the first column and explain the action taken on the back of the chart. *

Friendly reminder - refrigerators should be 41°F or lower; freezers should be between -10-0°F; dry storage areas should stay in the range of 50- 70°F.

* It's important to let a supervisor know if a temperature falls below the acceptable threshold as there may be a problem with the equipment.
